All-Plank Partition

The all-plank partition is common in public boarding facilities where compatibility issues between neighbouring horses often come into play. But the all-plank partition also has its place in private facilities. The personality of an individual horse may demand that it is kept separated from others both for its own safety as well as the safety of others. Additionally there may be logistical reasons for using the all-plank partition. For example you may simply want a solid wall between the stall and a feed, tack or wash area. Or you may have the stall next to an overhead door and you want to offer your horse some protection from the weather.

Open-Top Partition

In a private facility where the horses are comfortable with each other the open-top partition provides several benefits over the all-plank partitions including improved ventilation, better lighting and greater sensory stimulus. Being able to see and smell the other horses will create a more stimulating environment and reduce boredom stress vices such as cribbing.

All-Plank and Open-Top Partition

- A solid welded frame ensures your stalls set up quickly and easily with minimum labor costs
- A solid welded frame provides superior strength and rigidity for years of safe reliable service
- Heavy walled 1.9"OD, 14 gauge high tensile steel tubing frame construction for exceptional durability.
- All our box stalls use a common connector system so you can easily integrate various stall fronts and partitions
- The precision connector system creates a more rigid stall system which is safer, quieter, and more durable
- The fronts are finished with a durable and handsome hunter green, semi-gloss, powder coat finish

Open Top-Partition

- The upper grills are made with 1"OD vertical bars set safely on 4" centers (maximum 3" opening)
- The lower panels include integrated channels designed to accept 2x6 planed lumber (lumber not included)
- Lumber installation is easy, simply slide your lumber into the channels and screw the last piece in place
- Integrated steel channels protect wood edges from chewing horses
- Optional hay racks, corner feeders, and blanket hangers are available
- Frames are 7' high
